

Update of Academic Unit Carryforward Project Codes

In 2013, BIA and Accounting and Financial Services developed two new object consolidation codes, “Committed Obligations” (COBL) and “Known Obligations” (KOBL), to more easily track and record intended uses of carryforward balances in our financial system. Part of the recording of a COBL or KOBL requires establishing a project code beginning with “CF.” Based on a review of carryforward project codes used by the academic units (see Appendix for the full listing of carryforward project codes added or suggested by units in 2016), below is a list of codes that should be used consistently across campus when units have items that fit into these categories. Units may still use their own to address unit specific items.

Obligation Type/Description	Project Codes
Start-up funding for faculty recruitment: use xx to denote unit (1st two digits of organization code) and “####” for position number	CFSUxx or CFSTUP“####”
Retention funding for faculty: use “####” for position number as appropriate	CFRET“####”
Fellowships: use “####” for position number as appropriate	CFFSHP“####”
Endowed Chairs: use “####” for position number as appropriate	CFENDOW“####”
Contract employee: use “####” for position number if relevant	CFCONT
Summer session/seminar compensation	CFSSC
Equipment	CFEQUIP
Renovation	CFRENOV
Bridge funding: support between research grants	CFBRIDGE
All Others: designate appropriate abbreviation for “xxxx”	CFOTHER or CF“xxxx”
ACCD Commitments	CFACCD
Graduate programs/support	CFGRAD
Undergraduate instruction	CFINSTRUC
Matching commitments	CFMATCH
Faculty research	CFRESEARCH
Chair research	CFCHAIR
